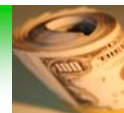

The Doctrine Of Prosperity, From Such Withdraw Thyself



Around 67 A.D. in a letter to Timothy, Paul prophesied of a time when people would not accept sound dogma. He wrote, “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears” (II Timothy 4:3). Centuries later, this prophecy has become manifest in one of the most fallacious doctrines in our day, the Prosperity Doctrine or Prosperity Theology. The prosperity doctrine is the doctrine that prosperity and success in business is external evidence of God’s favor. Predominant among the Pentecostal Church, many evangelists teach that God wants Christians to be successful in all areas, especially financially. Today, the Prosperity Doctrine is mainly established by taking several New Testament Scriptures out of context. The premise that Christians are entitled to have riches and wealth is not substantiated in the Holy Bible. And unfortunately due to their own lusts, teachers have compromised the salvation of multitudes by the principles of this false doctrine.

One of the writings that are taken out of con-

text is found in John 10:10 which reads, “The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.” Some ministers assert that the life more abundantly refers to being wealthy in this life. Read alone with an erroneous interpretation, this may seem to be legitimate.

However, when one reads further, it is evident that Jesus is referring to eternal life, not riches. In the 27th and 28th verses it is written, “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them **eternal life**; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand.”

Jesus never encouraged us to make earthly riches that will eventually perish a major concern; rather he encourages us to do righteous works so that we may enter into his kingdom. In Matthew 6 it is written, “24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon (money). 25 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?” Jesus’ attitude toward earthly riches was the complete opposite of wealth seeking ministers of today. He tells us what we should truly seek. Verse 33 reads, “**But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.**” God will provide our needs on earth if we have faith and serve him. However, our chief concern should be on fulfilling our requirements necessary to inherit the kingdom of God.

In a separate letter to Timothy, Paul warned of ministers who teach that prosperity and wealth is the evidence of God’s favor. Paul cautioned, “If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness; **Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.**”

For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have **erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.** But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. (I Timothy 6:3,4,10,11)” True Christians, should take heed to what Paul advised and withdraw from this unsound doctrine, which is contrary to the words of our Lord Jesus Christ.
