## Jesus Reigns And Kingdoms Overthrown, At The Last Trump



The plan of God is revealed to us through his Holy Days. God commanded us observe the Memorial of the Blowing of Trumpets in the seventh month, in the first day of the month. (Leviticus 23:24) This annual holy day was commissioned by God and points to the Second Coming of Jesus. In the Holy Scriptures a trumpet is blown for two purposes, the arrival of a king (Exodus 19:16-20), and to signify the preparation for battle (I Corinthians 14:8) At the Blowing of the Seventh Trumpet the Lord will descend with a shout and topple the kingdoms of this world, and reign as King of Kings.

The conquest of Jericho is a paradigm of what will happen to the kingdoms of this world at the Return of Jesus. In the days of Joshua, "The people shouted when the priests blew with the trumpets: and it came to pass, when the people heard the sound of the trumpet, and the people shouted with a great shout, that the wall fell down flat, so that the people went up into the city, every man straight before him, and they took the city" (Joshua 6:20). The priests of Jericho had seven trumpets and at the sound of the seventh trumpet the walls of Jericho fell. Similarly, the angels of the Lord have seven trumpets and at the sound of the seventh trumpet the Lord will overthrow the kingdoms of this world. Revelation 16 reads, "17 And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. 18 And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. 19 And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath." This king will come in war and take his kingship by force, at the last trump. In Revelation 11:15 it is written, "And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the

kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever."

We should observe the Memorial of the Blowing of Trumpets because its fulfillment means that the Lord will subdue all existing governments and be King over all the earth. By understanding the significance of this holy day, we can praise him with understanding. Psalm 47 reads, "1 O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph. 2 For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth. 3 He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. 4 He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah. 5 God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. 6 Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. 7 For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding."

## Before Ye See The Abomination of Desolation Stand In the Holy Place a Temple Must Be Built

It is clear through the Holy Scriptures that we are living in the last days. Today, we see wars, rumors of wars, famines, pestilence and earthquakes, all signs that we are approaching the Second Coming of Jesus. The most significant sign that Jesus gave was that the Anti-Christ will stand in the temple. This sign will ignite the 3 ½ year Great Tribulation, and after this Jesus will return. However, before ye see the Abomination of Desolation stand in the holy place, A Temple or Holy Place Must Be Built In Jerusalem.

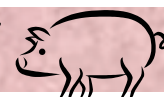
In 70 A.D. the Second Temple was destroyed by Titus when he laid siege on Jerusalem. Today, there is no Temple for the Abomination of Desolation to stand. A Third Temple is imminent because Jesus prophesied that the Anti-Christ will stand in the Third Temple in Jerusalem. In Mark 13:14 it is written, "But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains:" Matthew wrote that the place where the Anti-Christ will stand is a holy place (Matthew 24:15). Through the epistle of Paul to the Thessalonians we are informed about the holy place where this abominable man ought not to stand. II Thessalonians 2:3,4 reads, "3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God."

Presently, the main obstacle to building the Third Temple is two Moslem structures which are the Al Aqsa Mosque and the Dome of the Rock, the latter occupies the original location where the Second Temple once stood. The Dome of the Rock is one of the most famous Islamic shrines, and any attempt to take over this land would be viewed as a grave provocation and likely result in riot or even war. Also, it is highly unlikely that the Dome of the Rock will be removed to Mecca or Medina so that the Third Temple can be built in its original location. So exactly where will the Third Temple be built? John reveals the exact location of the Third Temple. In Revelation 11:1,2 it is written, "1 And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein. 2 But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. The Third Temple will be constructed in the Court Area of the Second Temple. The Court Area is given to the Gentiles to tread for 42 months or 3 ½ years, the time period of the Great Tribulation.

Today, many that occupy the Promised Land are preparing to build the Temple.

Once the Temple is built they will begin the daily sacrifice. The Anti-Christ will take over the land of Israel through arms, and will stop the daily sacrifice. Daniel 8:11 reads, "Yea, he magnified himself even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily sacrifice was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down." But be not deceived, in order for this to take place, A Temple Must Be Built.

## The Health Risk Of Consuming Pork "The Other White Meat"



God commanded us not to eat swine (Leviticus 11:7, Deuteronomy 14:8), which is reason enough not to eat it. Despite this, roughly 38% of all meat consumed in the world is pork, making it the most of any other animal. Pigs are more disposed to illnesses than other animals because they are scavengers. Swine eat dead insects, worms, maggots, rotting carcasses, excreta (including their own), garbage, and other pigs. One of the main illnesses that pigs share with humans is influenza (flu), and those who eat pork are more susceptible to influenza. Due to the high amount of cholesterol and saturated fat, eating pork can lead to gallstones and obesity. The pig is also the main carrier of the taenia solium worm; these are tapeworms that can be passed on to humans. These worms may lie in the intestines and nega-

tively affect other organs as well. Pig meat also contains mesenchymal mucus which leads to arthritis and rheumatism. In addition, the other white meat is not truly white at all, it is red and changes color when it is cooked. Advertisers utilized the word "white" so people will attribute to pork the health benefits of other clean animals, such as chicken and turkey. With all these risks, the main health hazard of eating pork is written in Isaiah 66,"16 For by fire and by his sword will the Lord plead with all flesh: and the slain of the Lord shall be many. 17 They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the abomination, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith the Lord."
