## A Sign of the Times

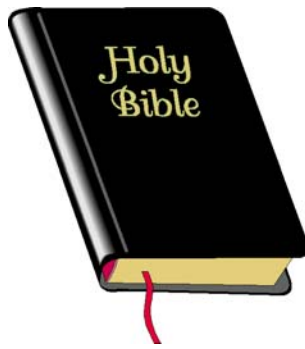
