### Jesus is Jehovah

When the Word became flesh (John 1:14) he gave up being God. Once flesh he humbled himself always giving honor to the Father. He was once God himself in the beginning (John 1:1-2) the only one who talked to Israel. The Bible let us know that no one has seen God the father at any time neither heard his voice. But they did see and hear Jehovah.

John 1:18 *No man hath seen God at any time, the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.* John tells us that no man has seen God. But the son let Israel know about him. Even Jesus tells us that no man has seen the Father.

John 5:37 *And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath born witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.*

Now if no one has seen his shape nor heard his voice, then this could not be the Father in Exodus. It was the Word before he became flesh.

Exodus 24: 9-12 *Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel: And they saw the God of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness. And upon the nobles of the children of Israel he laid not his hand: also they saw God, and did eat and drink. And the LORD said unto Moses, Come up to me in the mount, and be there: and I will give thee tables of stone, and a law, and commandments which I have written; that thou mayest teach them.*

Here Moses and the seventy-three others saw the God of Israel and heard his commands. Remember Jesus said **Ye have neither heard his**

**voice at any time, nor seen his shape.** But it was Jehovah who led Israel out of Egypt.

Jehovah let Moses know who he was and how he would be their God. Jehovah led Israel through the Red Sea. The New Testament will let us know something else about the God who led them through the Red Sea. There it calls Jehovah by the title given him by the Father.

1 Corinthians 10: 1-4 *Moreover, brethren, I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; And did all eat the same spiritual meat; And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ*

Paul tells us that Christ was the one that lead Israel through the sea. Remember in the Old Testament he was called Jehovah. Once again Jesus Christ is Jehovah. God the Father (like many fathers) named Jesus after him-

self. After all he became his son.

Phillipians 2: 5-11 *Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

Here Paul clearly states that the Father has given him a name above every name. The name of Jesus is even above Jehovah.

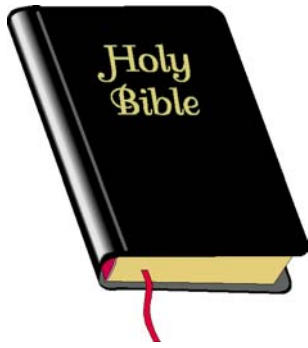

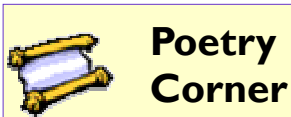

## Salvation is of the Jews
