True Love Established On the Law



How do we demonstrate that we truly love the Lord? Is it by the clapping of hands emphatically as we scream His name? Is our love for the creator demonstrated with dances and songs? Is it true that we can give thanks to him, but we need to do it with some understanding. God through His word has shown us what TRUE LOVE is and how we can truly love him. When asked by one of the Pharisees, "Master, which is the greatest commandment in the law", Jesus replied, "THOU SHALT LOVE THE LORD THY GOD WITH ALL THY HEART, AND WITH ALL THY SOUL, AND WITH ALL THY MIND (Matthew 22:38). This is the first and great commandment. But how do we express TRUE LOVE for God? Well, Jesus also told us, "if ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15). We express our love of God by being obedient to His law. Concerning the second greatest commandment Jesus stated, "And the second is like unto it, "THOU SHALT LOVE THY NEIGHBOR AS THYSELF" (Matthew 22:39).

Even before you can love God, it is essential that you have love for your fellow

man. In I John 4:20, 21 it is written, ²⁰"If a man say, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? ²¹ And this commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also. Paul affirms love for our neighbor in Romans 13:8-10. ⁸ Owe no man anything, but to love one another: for he that loveth another hath fulfilled the law. ⁹ For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. ¹⁰ Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: THEREFORE LOVE IS THE FULFILLING OF THE LAW. Jesus himself also sheds light on how we truly love our neighbor. Matthew 5:⁴⁴ But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; ⁴⁵ That ye may be the children of your Father which is in

heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. ⁴⁶ For if ye love them which love you, what reward have ye? Do not even the publicans the same? ⁴⁷ And if ye salute your brethren only, what do ye more than others? Do not even the publicans so? ⁴⁸ Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.

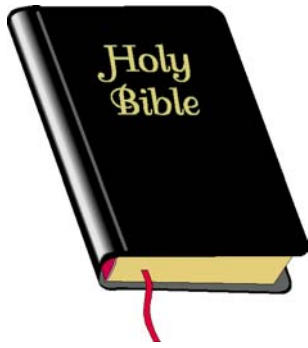
Understand, we cannot simply profess to love God and not do the things that he commands us to do. We must keep the Commandments of God, which include those pertaining to the Creator as well as our neighbor, in order to show TRUE LOVE. Jesus said, "He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him" (John 14:21). So ask yourself, "Do I truly love God?" Then ask yourself, "Do I keep the law?"

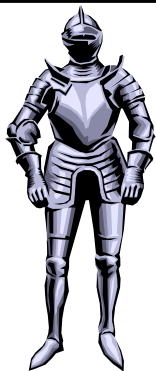

Don't... Passover The Feast of Unleavened Bread



God gave us the feast let us enjoy it! Approximately three thousand and five hundred years ago the Great and Omnipotent God revealed to Israel his plan for their salvation and deliverance from ancient Egypt. The focal point of this plan, which he commanded them to celebrate, was the Passover and The Feast of Unleavened Bread. Today, we are preparing to celebrate this same feast because God said, "...Therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever (Exodus 12:17)."

Sadly, many people are unaware of this great festival. Tradition teaches them that God's feasts are no longer valid therefore they have opted to celebrate man-made holidays (Easter, Xmas, etc...) instead. However, the verse quoted above said, "observe forever" and Jesus himself celebrated God's feasts. Jesus even died on the Passover, solidifying it's importance for all time, "Ye know that after two days is the feast of the Passover, and the

son of man is betrayed to be crucified (Matthew 26:2)."

God, who is all knowing, not only gave us this feast to commemorate Egypt but The Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread also honors the salvation and deliverance of all believers by Jesus, the Passover lamb. "...For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven..."

(I Corinthians 5:7,8). How can we overlook such a marvelous occasion given by the creator himself? Let us learn to enjoy the Passover/Feast of Unleavened Bread, honoring God for his mercy and grace!
