Beware! Poison!



DO NOT EAT!

A posted sign or label like the above title should definitely get our attention. Especially if someone handed us the product to eat with the label clearly seen.

We would wonder why a person would blatantly try to poison us and probably try to him them arrested. However, this very act is going on everyday all over the world.

The label is clear, Jesus said, **“Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep’s clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves” (Matthew 7:15)**. Many, who attend church regularly, have never considered the above warning because Jesus said again, **“And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many” (Matthew 24:11)**. You might say, well that’s fine and good but what does that have to do with eating poison? Everything, because just as you would avoid eating poison physically. More important, the whole bible warns us to beware of spiritual poison.

they ate an apple. Though Adam and Eve ate some fruit, it was not from an apple tree, but instead poison spiritual fruit. **“...Ye have eaten the fruit of lies...(Hosea 10:13)**. Today, many are eating the same fruit though the basket is clearly labeled, **“Beware of false prophets... Ye shall know them by their fruits.” (Matthew 7:15,16)**.

This is why God gave us the Feast of Unleavened Bread (which represents the good pure Word of God). However, after receiving Jesus the Passover lamb, we are not only commanded to eat unleavened bread for seven days but we must avoid all leavening as well. Again, the sign is posted, **“Then Jesus said unto them, Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees” (Matthew 16:6)**.

The disciples thought Jesus was warning them about physical bread, just like you might have thought this article was about literal poison. “Then understood they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees” (Matthew 16:12). Poison!

There Is No “Rapture” From Great Tribulation

There is a doctrine that is being perpetuated throughout many churches today called the doctrine of the Rapture. This particular doctrine is based on the premise that Jesus will return secretly, and rapture “believers” to heaven, before the Great Tribulation occurs. Although popular books have been written about the Rapture, the book that matters (Holy Bible) does *not* support this doctrine.

There are a few scriptures that are taken out of context to support this teaching, but the main support of this premise is found in the writings of Paul to the Thessalonians. In I Thessalonians 4 it is written, “16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: 17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.” Many Biblical Scholars and Theologians will claim that verses 16 and 17 refer to a rapture. However, Paul did not write that God’s servants will go to heaven where the Father and Son are, but rather that the saints will meet the Lord in the air, or sky. Jesus will resurrect his servants both dead and alive. They will meet him in the air and descend to the earth with him to wage war and establish his kingdom. In Zechariah it is written, 14:1 *Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee. 3 Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. 5 And ye shall flee to the valley of the mountains; for the valley of the mountains shall reach unto A-zal: yea, ye shall flee, like as ye fled from before the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah: and the Lord my God shall come, AND ALL THE SAINTS WITH THEE.* Those in the first resurrection will meet the Lord in the air and descend with Jesus to the earth. But when will this happen?

Understand, Jesus will not return until *after* the Great Tribulation is complete. In Matthew 24 it is written, “29 **IMMEDIATELY AFTER** the Great Tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: 30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then

In Matthew 24 it is written, “15 When ye therefore see the Abomination of Desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place; (whoso readeth, let him understand;) 16 **THEN LET THEM WHICH BE IN JUDEA FLEE INTO THE MOUNTAINS. 21 FOR THEN SHALL BE GREAT TRIBULATION SUCH AS WAS NOT SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THE WORLD TO THIS TIME, NO, NOR EVER SHALL BE.**” God has a place prepared in the wilderness for his servants to escape the Great Tribulation. John prophesied of this deliverance from Great Tribulation. In Revelation 12 it is written, “6 And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.” All those who are blessed to make it into the wilderness will be safe throughout the 3 ½ year Great Tribulation.

If you take scriptures out of context to establish a non-existent rapture, it will be to your own detriment. If you are expecting to be caught up in some rapture, what will happen when it does not take place and you are confronted with taking the Mark of the Beast? More than likely you will succumb because you have trusted in a lie. The problem with doing so is written in Revelation 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, if any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead or in his hand, 10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb. This is the problem with false doctrine such as the Rapture Doctrine. The word “*rapture*” is not even in the Holy Bible. Brothers and sisters, there is no “Rapture” from Great Tribulation
